Dear Brothers & Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes

"And they came with haste and they found Mary and Joseph, and the infant lying in the manger."

(Luke 2:16)

Blessings to you for the Christmas Season, the Solemn Feast of Mary Mother of God and the new year of 2023.

Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis have both written about the importance of Christ, as a child, as the center of our life. In this Christmas season, we grow closer to God as we meditate on his presence as an infant in Bethlehem and in the mystery of life made present through the children among us.

These are lessons which we can all learn about community and about vocation through the Christ child and through the lives of children.

CHILDREN AND COMMUNITY

All of you, have unity of spirit, sympathy, love of the brethren, a tender heart, and a humble mind. (1 Peter 3:8)

Pope Benedict reminded us that God is made in three persons in the Trinity, in the Holy Family, and in our families. That is, "[as] God is a communion of love; so is the family." God's salvation plan is still made known to us because families and –family members – are willing to sacrifice for each other. This began in Bethlehem and Nazareth and continues today. While we may need solitude to hear God's voice, we also need each other to practice God's commandments and to know God's consolation.

In this regard, our acts of contrition or penance within the family and not only so that we may be healed personally but that the whole body of the family may grow stronger.

(Benedict XVI, 27 December 2009, Holy Family Sunday).

CHILDREN AND VOCATION

For unto us a child is born, a son is given. (Isaiah 9:6)

This family-community is also the necessary path for a child – including the child Jesus – to know his calling and vocation. In this regard, Jesus does not escape from his family to the Temple, but rather goes there because of what he had learned at home. Benedict XVI observes: "We may therefore say that Jesus' decision to stay on at the Temple was above all the result of his close relationship with the Father, but it was also a result of the education he had received from Mary and Joseph. Here we can glimpse the authentic meaning of Christian education: it is the fruit of a collaboration between educators and God that must always be sought. The Christian family is aware that children are a gift and a project of God." (Benedict, 27 December 2009)

I hope and pray that the prayer of this Christmas Season will help each of us to know God's love in Christ through our own relationships and community and also to know God's call and vocation for each of us.




