We serve God by providing spiritual, educational, and social activities for our parish family as well as extending God's love and compassion to serve the greater community.



Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes

As we kick off the Annual Appeal of 2024, I wish to thank you for your gifts toward the 2023 Appeal which exceeded our goal and gained a parish rebate of \$2,969.

I am grateful to you, our regular sustaining donors, who have helped us year after year. I am also grateful to our new donors for the Annual Appeal of 2023.

I recognize that these are very trying times due to the effects of inflation and economic uncertainties. You have come through for your parish family, at a difficult time. Your gifts enabled the Archdiocese of Newark to reach its \$9 million goal. Also, because we reached our parish-specific goal by June 30, Lourdes received a \$12,000 reduction in assessment expenses.

Our goal for 2024 is \$28,210, which is the same as 2023. We again ask your help to reach our goal by June 30, to achieve the same reduction of \$12,000 in assessment expenses. The Appeal supports vital ministries in collaboration with other parishes of the Archdiocese of Newark -- in the four counties of Essex, Union, Hudson and Bergen -- including these key areas and examples:

<u>WORSHIP OF GOD</u> for <u>Persons with</u> <u>Disabilities:</u> The Archdiocese provides a Mass in Essex County (and the other counties) for the hearing impaired plus social gathering at St. John's Newark.

WORD OF GOD for Future Priests:

Your support is vital to the education of future priests through the ministry of Father Bob Suszko (Seminary Vice Rector), parish weekend assistant, and other priests and professors at our Seminary at Seton Hall University.

WORD OF GOD for College Campus

Ministry: Your support enables Father Jim Chern, Montclair State University chaplain and parish weekend assistant, to build up Catholic communities on 9 university campuses.

WORKS OF CHARITY *For the needy:*

Catholic Charities serves the most vulnerable with food, nutrition, shelter, job training, and more.

In addition to the ministry provided beyond our parish by your gifts, the Appeal also benefits us directly in the following ways:

- (1) <u>Catholic Charities / Education</u>. The students and faculty in our school building are a division of Catholic Charities, "Mount Carmel Guild Academy" (MCGA). MCGA serves the needs of children with special learning and behavioral needs. The rent paid to Lourdes by MCGA for the use of our school is vital to our operating income. Catholic Charities is a recipient of Annual Appeal Funds.
- (2) Endowment Grants. In 2023, Lourdes Parish received a grant of \$25,000 for the improvement of our heating and air conditioning. In addition to this grant, Lourdes has received \$60,000 in grants since 2014 for various needs. This funding for the 2023 grant and earlier grants originates from the Annual Appeal.
