Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Gospel of this Sunday, our Savior is at a crossroads in the Temple area. Some of the folks on this sidewalk fear that he would destroy the building, the edifice of the Temple.

Yet, our Savior was only asking – as he asks you and me – what are we doing with our inside spiritual knowledge – with our inside information about the Temple and the Holy Spirit.

The money changers and merchants are criticized for their price structure and menu options. These would suggest that salvation – or faith – is for sale on the street or online or that they have a special insider deal.

Jesus accepted that a faithful Jewish person would bring a sacrifice to the Temple. Yet, he was asking them to consider that their more important sacrifice is the sacrifice of their own lives, their comfort for the other. The insiders, then, are not necessarily wealthy but they are willing to share what they have for greater intimacy with God and their neighbor.

Remove your talent from the ground, your light from under the bushel basket. (Matthew 5:15)

This completes our offering to God from whom we have also received inside information about strength and love.
