Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

This Sunday – July 16-17 – is our Missionary Cooperative Appeal. Please see bulletin page 5 summarizing the mission of the Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Nyeri (Kenya).

This is to share with you a reflection of Pope Francis relating this Sunday's Gospel – Martha and Mary – to Christian family life. Pope Francis has written and spoken frequently about the importance of family life and family bonds.

Pope Francis reminds us that prayer is the method by which we make every moment time and every task holy. Growing closer to God, we also make more of the scarce time and resources we have.

Pope Francis wrote:

We know well that family time is a complicated and crowded time, busy and preoccupied. There is always little, there is never enough, there are so many things to do. One who has a family soon learns to solve an equation that not even the great mathematicians know how to solve: within 24 hours they make twice that many ... The spirit of prayer gives time back to God, it steps away from the obsession of a life that is always lacking time, it rediscovers the peace of necessary things, and discovers the joy of unexpected gifts.

Two good guides for this are the sisters Martha and Mary, spoken of in the Gospel we have just heard; they learned from God the harmony of family rhythms: the beauty of celebration, the serenity of work, the spirit of prayer (cf. Luke 10:38-42). The visit of Jesus, whom they loved, was their celebration. However, one day Martha learned that the work of hospitality, though important, is not everything, but that listening to the Lord, as Mary did, was the really essential thing, the “best kind” of time. Prayer flows from listening to Jesus, from reading the Gospel. Do not forget to read a passage of the Gospel every day. Prayer flows from closeness with the Word of God. Is there this closeness in our family?

Do we have the Gospel at home? Do we open it sometimes to read it together? Do we meditate on it while reciting the Rosary? The Gospel read and meditated on as a family is like good bread that nourishes everyone's heart. In the morning and in the evening, and when we sit at the table, we learn to say together a prayer with great simplicity ... you, mother, father, teach your child to pray, to make the Sign of the Cross: this is a lovely task for mothers and fathers! In the prayer of the family, in its intense moments and in its difficult seasons, we are entrusted to one another, so that each one of us in the family may be protected by the love of God. (Pope Francis, *General Audience*, 26 August 2015)

We pray that the Holy Father's ministry may bring many of us to renewed faith in our Church as one family and our family as the means by which we come to know ourselves as the Body of Christ, the Church.

Through our Family Catechesis and Religious Education program, we hope to assist you – as parents, as families, as children as siblings – to practice the faith in your service and hospitality to each other and by each other. By you, our families, many gifts are brought to God's altar; and, through you, we cherish and practice the virtues of faith, hope and charity.

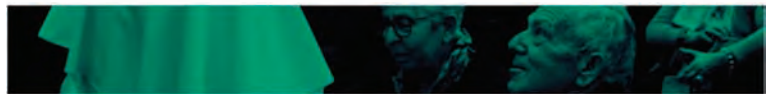

Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Nyeri is a women religious community that was founded in Kenya by Bishop Filipo Perlo and three founding members in 1918. In founding the congregation, Bishop Perlo, an Italian missionary, believed that anyone who would become part of the new community would walk in the footsteps of Jesus Christ in caring for the poor, the needy, and the suffering. Today, more than 400 sisters actively serve in teaching, healthcare, pastoral care, and a variety of social ministries in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Italy and the U.S.

In Kiamumbi — one of Nairobi’s outlying neighborhoods — children live in squalid slum conditions and are often orphaned, neglected and abused. For this reason, Maria Immaculata Children’s Education Center serves as a beacon of hope. Founded in 1997 by the Sisters of Mary Immaculate, this combined home and school helps the area’s neediest children grow into healthy, productive members of society. Its mission is to instill moral and spiritual values through care, encouragement, education and community intervention. Maria Immaculata Children’s Education Center helps these deserving children realize their full potential and rise above the difficult socioeconomic circumstances from which they come.

Every day, the Sisters of Mary Immaculate (SMI) are summoned by God to behold the wonders He has done for them, discern how the gift they received is continually unfolding before us and continually develop it with the personal charism that He has implanted in our hearts.

- *By vowing for chastity, we have “chosen to give ourselves totally to Jesus” and in renouncing marriage, we have “chosen Him alone.”*
 - *By vowing for poverty, we have “renounced all-possessions as well as relations-out of the love” of Jesus.*
