We are inspired by the Gospel of Jesus Christ, nourished by the Eucharist, called to respect life and proclaim our Catholic faith. We serve God by providing spiritual, educational, and social activities for our parish family as well as extending God's love and compassion to serve the greater community.



Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Our biblical readings this Sunday remind us that we are called to seek holiness and God's presence, but there are certainly obstacles that may block us on our path. While these challenges ask us to change our ways, they also remind us that we are seeking not an alternate – but an authentic – identity in Christ. St. Catherine of Siena wrote: "Be who you were created to be, and you will set the world on fire."

I share with you some of the lessons from the readings of this Sunday, in these key words from each reading: LABORING, LISTENING, LAYERING, LEGACY.

[LABORING]. <u>1st Reading. Ecclesiastes 1:2,</u> <u>2:21-23. "What profit comes to a man from all his</u> <u>toil?"</u> We extend ourselves mentally and manually, to labor and produce results. Labor is also the work of our mothers from the very beginning of our lives. The Canadian author Jean Little is known for the famous quote: "A man may work from sun to sun but a woman's work is never done." Labor is an extension of effort and time.

The lesson of Ecclesiastes is meant to console us and to remind us that some of things we chase after may not have a lasting value. For this reason, the author speaks of "vanity" which, in this case, does not refer to excessive concern with one's fitness or face, but rather a caution against seeking that which is "in vain" or empty. Working and earning a paycheck do not make you "vain", but sometimes our concern with material things or comforts is a form of vanity because it does not provide the fulfillment which only God and true love provide.

[LISTENING]. <u>Psalm 95. "If today you hear</u> <u>his voice, harden not your hearts.</u>" All day long, we encounter sounds, pings, buzzes, vibrations, alarms and advertising. To whom are you and I listening? The 95th psalm is prayed by all sisters and brothers and priests, in the in Liturgy of the Hours. While this Liturgy has an annual cycle of many psalms and readings, the 95th is only one that is prayed 365 days of the year. The prophet Elijah famously gave us the example of one who had been expecting God in the wind, earthquake, or fire but actually encounters him in a quiet voice. Elijah is called to focus and turn down the volume on other sounds in order to hear God's voice. Are we willing to turn down the volume in order to reflect and pray?

[LAYERING]. <u>Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11 "Seek</u> what is above where Christ is." In order to be prepared for sudden changes in weather and temperature, it is helpful to bring along – or wear – different types of clothing that can be removed or put on as needed. This same technique of "layering" is one that we might practice in our pursuit of happiness. St. Paul cautions us that dishonesty or lying between persons can become a layer or obstacle to authentic relationships. St. Paul urges to us to take off the "layer" of our "old self".

[LEGACY]. <u>Luke 12:13-21 "The things you</u> <u>have prepared, to whom will they belong?</u>" In 1982, Charles Feeney (Elizabeth, NJ) created a charitable foundation by giving away all his stock in a company called "Duty Free Shipping Group" (DFS).

This amounted to a \$500 million gift and was just the start of his philanthropy. Not even his DFS business partners knew that he no longer personally owned any part of DFS. For the next 15 years, Charles Feeney donated money secretly leading to him being dubbed the "James Bond" of philanthropy, only emerging from anonymity in 1997 when he was forced to do so, to comply with civil law.

Currently, Charles Feeney lives in a 2bedroom apartment in San Francisco and has given away nearly \$8 billion, with the goal of giving away a total of \$9 billion before his death.


