Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Our biblical readings this Sunday remind us that the Lord God seeks you out – especially when you are lost.

St. Paul wrote: “But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”
(Ephesians 2:13)

I share with you some lessons from the readings of this Sunday, with a reflection on the meaning of each of these key words: **__GOLD, __FOLD, __SOLD, __HOLD.**

[GOLD] Exodus 32:7-11,13-14 The precious metal of gold is currently priced at \$1,073 per ounce. The Hebrew people also knew that gold was valuable, even coming to worship their gold. Moses, as their prophet and leader, was frustrated that the people had transformed what was “in their wallet” (gold) to something they could worship, a god. This is the episode of the “Golden Calf” in which the people melt their gold and jewelry to create this new idol. They have done this because God seems distant and Moses himself had been on the mountain for 40 days. Pope Francis stated in January 2020 that worship of God is not only a choice between “God” and mammon” (money) but also between “my will” and “God’s will”. I must admit I often prefer my own! The problem is not only that I can turn my gold into an idol but that I can also idolize my opinions, my skepticism, or my talents. Anything I claim for myself can lead me away from God’s way. Pope Francis stated: “When we do not worship God ... We end up worshipping ourselves ... Worship means realizing that you and God belong together. It means being able to speak to him freely and intimately.” (Pope Francis, Epiphany Homily, January 6, 2020) Silence before God and in prayer

is also “golden”. This is a treasure we can spend both now and in heaven.

[FOLD] Psalms 51 Whether as a competitor in sports or a worker in the heat of the day, we can know what it means to “fold” or “give up” against certain overwhelming obstacles or odds. The 51st psalm is attributed to King David, also a great competitor and warrior. Yet, David was now “folding” or in danger of doing so. His enemy was not in another land but in himself, his sinfulness. King David had come to realize his need for mercy and redemption. While powerful in many legal and political ways, David had perpetrated a great scandal (the affair with Bathsheba) and been the author of an innocent man’s death (Uriah the Hittite, husband of Bathsheba). Becoming aware of this, David is repenting before God: “Have mercy on me God in your kindness” (Psalm 51:1) While aware of his guilt and wrongdoing, David does not “fold” due to his sin. God’s mercy shores him up. The psalm reminds us that when we put ourselves before God, admitting our sins, evil can be defeated “folded” and put to death, while you and I are raised up.

[SOLD] 1 Timothy 1:12-17 When we speak of being “betrayed” or cheated, we might compare this to being “sold” as though everything we had of value has been taken. It is a fate we try to avoid and expect legal protection against (e.g., civil rights laws of non-discrimination). Jesus’ own suffering and death was precipitated by a “sale”, perpetrated by Judas Iscariot of his inner circle. This episode of Jesus’ arrest and crucifixion showed that he loved us because he was willing to be sold: “Christ Jesus came into this world to save sinners.” (1 Timothy 1:15)

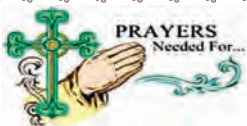

[HOLD] Luke 15:1-32 The parables of Luke, Ch. 15, show how much the Lord loves us and seeks out after us, and longs to hold us again. The lost sheep, lost coin, lost son demonstrated his hold on us and value for us, and that you and I are measured as individuals (1 coin, 1 sheep, 1 person) not simply as percentages in a portfolio Jesus wants to hold us. The father of the Prodigal/Lost Son parable abandons everything to “hold” his son again. The father is willing to wait for the son who abandoned him. The Lord also waits for you and for me, to hold us again as his own.

On the 9/11 Anniversary, for those who died as rescue workers, as Police, Fire and EMS responders, as travelers, in the air and on the ground, “Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. ~Amen~”
