#### Sisters of Mary Immaculate (SMI) Charism

Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Nyeri is a religious family that has inherited the precious gift of the Holy Spirit's passion and compassion that irrupted in the consciousness of our founders Mother Julia Muthoni, Mother Jusepha Wambui, Sr. Filippina Njeri and Bishop Filipo Perlo.

Every day, we are summoned by God to behold the wonders He has done for them, discern how the gift they received is continually unfolding before us and continually develop it with the personal charism that He has implanted in our hearts.

#### Ministry Example # 1 -- Mary Immaculate Hospital

Charitable Donations Provide Medicine & Basic Medical Equipment

About two and a half hours north of Nairobi, in the highlands near Mt. Kenya, the Missionary Sisters provide healthcare for the poorest people who live in the region. For many of those living in this area of central Kenya, Mary Immaculate Hospital is their only hope for medicine and professional assistance if they become sick.

While many Americans might not understand the remoteness of poverty of this region, the territory where the hospital is situated is so poor that only recently were the Sisters able to obtain water for the hospital itself. Prior to that, our Sisters would have to walk to a local river to get water for themselves and the patients. Needless to say -- we thank God for the gift of water there!

Because Mary Immaculate Hospital offers medical care for some of the poorest people of Africa, the Sisters rely on charitable donations to fund the continued working of the facility. At this moment, this hospital as well as other medical facilities are in desperate need of medicine and basic medical equipment. The Sisters hope to purchase several pieces of used x-ray equipment which would help in the diagnosis of tuberculosis in adults as well as children. Without a doubt, this could save the lives of countless men, women and children!

#### Ministry Example # 2 --Divine Shelter of Love Orphanage

Donations Provide Orphans with Primary & Secondary Education

Located in Mweiga 2 hours north of Nairobi, the Divine Shelter of Love Orphanage provides food, shelter, clothing, medicine and education to some of the hundreds of boys and girls in the region who have lost both parents as a result of diseases such as AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis. Children living at the orphanage also receive primary as well as secondary education from the Missionary Sisters of Mary Immaculate.

#### Ministry Example # 3 - City of Nyeri

Donations Help Provide an Education for Poor Children

The city of Nyeri is located in central Kenya -approximately 2 hours north of Nairobi, the nations' capital. With the congregation's mother house located here, Nyeri is the spiritual center of the Missionary Sisters of Mary Immaculate ... where new Sisters profess their vows and all administrative functions concerning the life of the congregation are headquartered. It is also here that the Sisters provide outreach to orphans, education for poor children and medical care for the indigent.

The Vatican has released Pope Francis' message for the second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which will be celebrated on 24 July on the theme 'In old age they will still bear fruit'.

Welcoming the message, Catherine Wiley, Founder of the Catholic Grandparents' Association said, "We are overjoyed to read the wonderful message that the Holy Father has offered to us for this year's World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in which he is reminding us of the importance of us persevering in hope and of our great power to transform the world through prayer and a revolution of tenderness.

I am so encouraged to read his message for this year's great celebration for the World Day. It will strike at the heart of Grandparents across the world especially his comments about the ageing process when he said,

'Many people are afraid of old age. They consider it a sort of disease with which any contact is best avoided. The elderly, they think, are none of their concern and should be set apart, perhaps in homes or places where they can be cared for, lest we have to deal with their problems. This is the mindset of the "throw-away culture", which leads us to think that we are somehow different from the poor and vulnerable in our midst, untouched by their frailties and separated from "them" and their troubles. The Scriptures see things differently. A long life – so the Bible teaches - is a blessing, and the elderly are not outcasts to be shunned but living signs of the goodness of God who bestows life in abundance. Blessed is the house where an older person lives! Blessed is the family that honors the elderly!'

"Blessed indeed is the home and the family that welcomes Grandparents and Elders! Blessed also is the home where elderly Grandparents and family members care for each other at all ages and stages of life."

The three-story brick building in addition to a basement measures approximately 6,900 square feet.
