Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

#### **Uphill** and Downhill

In a 1957 exploration and hike in the Colorado Rockies, Earl Eaton and Pete Siebert walked for seven hours. Eaton had convinced Siebert that their long walk would pay off by revealing a mountain – and future downhill skiing locale -- that few others would know about.

Eaton, a native of the area, had avidly hiked and hunted, and thoughtfully noted many high-altitude spots in the Rockies. This insider knowledge led to the seven-hour hike. Sharing in this particular discovery and vision, Eaton and Siebert established Vail Ski Resort.

In 2000, Seibert wrote in his book, *Vail: Triumph of a Dream,* "The only reason someone hadn't already developed [at Vail] was because no one could see the top slopes or the miraculous Back Bowls from the valley below."

These entrepreneurs – Eaton and Siebert – walked a long way to reach the top of the mountain, the top of an undiscovered mountain.

In this, we see the effort required in discernment. Sometimes, we walk a long way. And, we don't necessarily have the encouragement of others in our quest. Others might think we are wasting our time. We also need some insider knowledge.

We need some insider knowledge of our own selves and insider knowledge of God who made us. Before venturing out into your – or my – distinct wilderness, we might not discern the difficulties present in the various mountains, people, and projects of our lives.

Sometime we feel discouraged and imagine all of them to be the same or that it is a complete white-out condition without a signal.

We feel anxious when we encounter a new mountain or stretch of undiscovered land. Venturing beyond our usual experience and expertise, we face unfamiliar questions.

In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 5:38-48), Jesus continued the Sermon on the Mount, giving also the lofty ideal that one should "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." (Matthew 5:44). In this regard, love is not simply a shelter in a storm. In fact, at times, even in loving relationships, we experience instability. Love is not a place where we simply stop for refreshment. Love is our map and navigation. It may require us to see what is hard to envision and to move forward when we feel stuck.

At times, our selfishness may get the best of us. And, we may be tripped up again and again in the same ways in our struggles.

Yet, this is also the experience of learning who you are - and who I am - in Christ and in God who made us. By learning these things that make us strong or weak, upright or off balance, we also grow closer to God. We also learn this by seeking forgiveness of our sins.

This is also our journey in the Lenten Season which began this past Ash Wednesday with the 40 Days of Lent and continues today, the 1st Sunday of Lent.

This may take us to the desert or the mountain, to vistas and to valleys previously unknown. With Christ's help, the visibility is quite good.




