Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

In the age-old social media/gathering at the water cooler or street corner, we have always sought to fill in the blanks of information. From office chatter to playground gossip, I myself often desire the latest news and desire to interpret it myself. Do you? This innate curiosity leads us to ask questions like "Have you heard about..." or "What have you heard about...", driving us to seek truth amidst the chatter of others.

Yet, after the tumultuous events of the Passion and Death of Jesus, the disciples found themselves isolated and withdrawn. Hiding in the upper room, they were locked in their own world, perhaps talking but likely not truly listening to each other. However, with the Resurrection, they were drawn out of their seclusion by reports of the empty tomb, initiating a journey towards understanding the profound significance of these events.

Just as Martha professed her faith in Jesus as the Messiah despite her grief over her brother Lazarus, we too must come to comprehend the deeper meaning behind the trials and triumphs we face. The Good News extends beyond the immediate challenges we encounter, offering hope and purpose that transcends temporal circumstances. It's a message that may take time to fully grasp, as evidenced by the disciples' initial lack of understanding regarding Jesus' resurrection.

Similarly, not everyone readily embraces the truth of Christ's death and resurrection. Each of us may struggle to believe, experiencing fluctuations in our faith akin to the varying size of our own mustard seed. Yet, just as Jesus assures us that even the smallest faith can grow, we are encouraged to persevere in our journey of belief, learning from the example of the disciples who accompanied Jesus through their own uncertainties.

Crucially, listening emerges as a vital virtue in our quest for understanding. The wisdom of St. James reminds us to be quick to listen and slow to speak, fostering patience and empathy towards others, particularly those whose voices may often go unheard. It's a call to embody Christ's compassion and attentiveness, especially towards those marginalized or overlooked in society.

Moreover, listening extends beyond mere words, encompassing the ability to overhear the unspoken truths that permeate our surroundings. While not advocating for invasive surveillance, this form of attentive observation allows us to glean valuable insights into human behavior and relationships, enriching our understanding of ourselves and others.

In every sphere of life – be it at school, at home, or within our broader communities – listening serves as a conduit for deeper connection and comprehension. By actively engaging with the questions, concerns, and experiences of those around us, we not only expand our own perspectives but also cultivate bonds of empathy and mutual respect.

Within the familial setting, in particular, listening becomes a means of both learning and loving. By attentively observing interactions and behaviors, we gain invaluable insights into the character and values of those closest to us, nurturing relationships founded on understanding and trust.

Ultimately, the message of Easter reminds us to remain vigilant and receptive, even amidst the noise and uncertainty of life. While we may encounter moments of doubt or despair, the triumph of Jesus over sin and death reaffirms our hope and strengthens our resolve to listen, learn, and love in accordance with the Good News. As we open our ears and hearts to the transformative power of Christ's resurrection, we find solace and inspiration to navigate life's journey with courage and compassion.
