"In my Father's house, there are many mansions. If not, I would have told you, because I go to prepare a place for you." (John 14:2)

Prepared for all of us is a place to pray in silence, to lift up our voices and hymnals at Sunday Mass, and to unite our petitions and hopes to others before God.

For one hundred and ten years, we have had the blessing of our worship at Our Lady of Lourdes. This anniversary reminds us of the gifts and sacrifices that we have enjoyed and shared. And, while anniversaries are moments to savor and mark with individual feeling, they also remind us of a continuing and common journey.

I pray Founder's Day allows us to recall the devotion of our religious sisters, brothers, deacons, and priests and also the guidance of our mothers and fathers and elders who taught us the Catholic faith by word and example. Sharing memories, we tell the Good News of God's grace in our lives.

We are grateful to our Heritage Committee through whom our Heritage Room gallery of images and documents is maintained and updated. I invite you to visit our Heritage Room (located near the Mississippi Avenue entrance) to see the photos or read one of the binders organized by decade of our history. Lourdes – in all our worship, prayer, sacrifice – is a work of both the Holy Spirit and you – the holy people of God.

This work of God's creation in West Orange officially started on Sunday, November 8, 1914 with the first Mass at 7:00 am at 180 High Street at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Byrne, with a second Mass at 9:00 am. Acts of faith and love are first practiced and shared within our own front doors. They take place in the living room and dining room. They happen in the car and minivan. And, they exist in the way we speak to and speak about each other.

The lessons of being a mother or a father or a friend begin even before we step outside our home or leave our home. We learn affections and actions at home to help us in all our relationships. Similarly, we learn about listening at home. We listen not only by what our mothers and fathers say but also by what they choose not to say.

At home, we also learn to speak with a certain vocabulary and volume. That is, we convert ourselves from the outside voice of the playground or playing field where our listener may be distant to the inside voice of the kitchen or corridor where we stand closer. However, the "inside voice" is important not only because we are standing physically nearer. The "inside voice" is also our conscience and the Holy Spirit which unites us in ways that we cannot see. Nevertheless, the presence is real and prepares us for the Real Presence of Christ sacrificed and risen at the altar and in the tabernacle.

In these and other experiences, our hearts have been prepared to receive the living God in prayer, in the sacrament of penance and reconciliation (confession), and in Holy Communion in our spiritual home at church.

Jesus himself is the visitor to our homes and lives. He is the visitor both subtle and bold, speaking the truth to Martha and Mary at home. In their home, we see the ideal that he is welcomed and heard both by the busy Martha and resting Mary. In either case, our Savior visits and wants to talk with us about what we are doing and feeling.

I pray that our Founder's Day – and your home always - may be a time where we can experience the love of God and the love of neighbor and recall the blessing of the decades and, now, the second century of Lourdes.
