Dear Brothers & Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Blessed Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes (February 11). *Notre Dame de Lourdes, priez pour nous*. Our Lady of Lourdes, Pray for Us!

**Biography** Saint Bernadette of Lourdes (1844-1879) is the kneeling figure in the mosaic above our altar, being the only direct witness to the apparitions of the Virgin Mary at Lourdes. Frail in health, Bernadette was the eldest of nine siblings in a financially struggling family, her father working as a miller. Bernadette played a pivotal role in establishing the Marian shrine of Lourdes and leaves a lasting legacy. Pope Benedict XVI spoke of what Bernadette heard and what our Blessed Mother spoke in the apparitions:

"The message which Our Lady still offers at Lourdes recalls the words Jesus said at the beginning of his public mission and that we hear so often in [the] first days of Lent: 'Convert and believe in the Gospel, pray and do penance. Let us respond to the call of Mary who echoes that of Christ and let us ask her to help us 'enter' Lent with faith and live this season of grace with deep joy and generous commitment" (Benedict XVI, Angelus, February 10, 2008)

I would like to share with you a Lenten message as we approach Ash Wednesday March 5 with a message from St. Peter Chrysologus

**Biography** Saint Peter Chrysologus (406-450) was archbishop of Ravenna (Italy) and earned the title "Chrysologus" (Golden Orator) later, likely to establish a Western counterpart to Eastern patriarch St. John Chrysostom. A confidant of Pope St. Leo I the Great, Peter gained esteem in both Western and Eastern churches for his orthodox teachings. Peter has several sermons emphasizing

Christian doctrines and responsibilities. I share with you one about the Lenten disciplines.

#### A SERMON ON PRAYER, FASTING, AND MERCY BY ST. PETER CHRYSOLOGUS

There are three things, my brethren, by which faith stands firm, devotion remains constant, and virtue endures. They are prayer, fasting and mercy. Prayer knocks at the door, fasting obtains, mercy receives. Prayer, mercy and fasting: these three are one, and they give life to each other.

Fasting is the soul of prayer, mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. Let no one try to separate them; they cannot be separated. If you have only one of them or not all together, you have nothing.

So if you pray, fast; if you fast, show mercy; if you want your petition to be heard, hear the petition of others. If you do not close your ear to others you open God's ear to yourself.

When you fast, see the fasting of others. If you want God to know that you are hungry, know that another is hungry. If you hope for mercy, show mercy. If you look for kindness, show kindness. If you want to receive, give. If you ask for yourself what you deny to others, your asking is a mockery.

Let this be the pattern for all men when they practice mercy: show mercy to others in the same way, with the same generosity, with the same promptness, as you want others to show mercy to you.

Therefore, let prayer, mercy and fasting be one single plea to God on our behalf, one speech in our defense, a threefold united prayer in our favor.

Let us use fasting to make up for what we have lost by despising others. Let us offer our souls in sacrifice by means of fasting. There is nothing more pleasing that we can

offer to God, as the psalmist said in prophecy: A sacrifice to God is a broken spirit; God does not despise a bruised and humbled heart.

Offer your soul to God, make him an oblation of your fasting, so that your soul may be a pure offering, a holy sacrifice, a living victim, remaining your own and at the same time made over to God. Whoever fails to give this to God will not be excused, for if you are to give him yourself you are never without the means of giving.

To make these acceptable, mercy must be added. Fasting bears no fruit unless it is watered by mercy. Fasting dries up when mercy dries up. Mercy is to fasting as rain is to earth. However much you may cultivate your heart, clear the soil of your nature, root out vices, sow virtues, if you do not release the springs of mercy, your fasting will bear no fruit.

When you fast, if your mercy is thin your harvest will be thin; when you fast, what you pour out in mercy overflows into your barn. Therefore, do not lose by saving, but gather in by scattering. Give to the poor, and you give to yourself. You will not be allowed to keep what you have refused to give to others. - St. Peter Chrysologus


