Dear Brothers & Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes was February 11. This is an abridged version of my homily for Sunday February 9 when we also observed Masses in Honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Our Lady of Lourdes.

This homily is a reflection on the Gospel of the Miraculous Catch of Fish (Luke 5:1-11) and Bernadette's own miraculous experience of the apparitions of the Blessed Mother.

#### <u>Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes & This Sunday's</u> <u>Gospel (Luke 5:1-11)</u>

The Gospel episode of Jesus leading the disciples to a miraculous catch of fish follows a night of darkness and failure, bringing the dawn of new direction.

There is a familiar saying: "It is always darkest before the dawn." This holds true for the disciples – in the dark with no fish — and also scientifically and spiritually.

I recently experienced this in a way that told me something —losing (and later finding) my phone. As I turned off the lights one night, I realized the phone was missing. I searched multiple times, called my own number, but heard no ring tone. Like Peter and the apostles fishing through the night, I was in the dark, catching nothing. Eventually, I gave up and went to sleep, unsettled.

After searching in vain, I gave up, feeling unsettled. The next morning, someone introduced me to the "Find My Device" app, which made my phone ring—even on silent. To my relief (and mild embarrassment), I found it under a pile of dishes. A small lesson: guidance and clarity come when we are open to receiving them.

#### **Darkness & Discouragement**

Have you ever felt your efforts—to find a solution, communicate, or forgive—were in vain? Like Peter, we may struggle without results. Darkness brings discouragement, but daylight brings direction.

#### Faith & Trust

The Gospel reminds us to turn to God, especially when all seems lost. Just as Peter followed Jesus'

instruction and cast his nets again, we too are called to trust. Often, we resist asking for help, yet grace enters when we do.

#### Our Lady of Lourdes

This Sunday, we honor Our Lady of Lourdes, who appeared to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. Despite hardship, Bernadette received the vision of a "beautiful lady" who identified herself as "I am the Immaculate Conception." Though Lourdes became a place of miraculous healings, Bernadette herself did not benefit materially. Instead, she embraced humility, dedicating her life to God in quiet service.

#### What is a Miracle?

John Henry Newman observed that miracles may capture attention but don't necessarily change hearts. Many seek miracles in sports, health, or finances, yet the greatest miracles are often unseen—like a transformed heart.

Consider love: on a first date, emotions may be overwhelming, but love deepens through commitment, sacrifice, and faith. Similarly, Jesus' miracles weren't for spectacle but to reveal His presence and call us to deeper trust.

#### **Seeing Beyond the Extraordinary**

Jesus called Peter not just to witness but to participate in the miracle. Likewise, miracles in our lives invite us to trust, reflect, and act.

While I was grateful to find my phone, it hasn't made me perfectly mindful of where I place it. Similarly, witnessing a miracle doesn't automatically instill lifelong faith. Instead, we are called to recognize God's constant presence beyond extraordinary moments.

#### The Greatest Miracle

Recognizing his sinfulness, Peter fell before Jesus, yet Christ called him to follow. So too, before Communion, we acknowledge:

\*"Lord, I am not worthy... but only say the word, and my soul shall be healed."\*

May Mary, Mother of Mercy, intercede for us. Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us. Notre Dame de Lourdes, priez pour nous.






